An introduction to the new accreditation models

New accreditation options allow you to choose the right model for your business

NewGen ISS is implementing three new accreditation models which will provide travel agents with added choice and flexibility. Travel agents will be able to choose the accreditation model best suited to their business and will have the flexibility to change their accreditation type as their business evolves. What are the accreditation models?



GoLite: Standard Accreditation with no cash facility

- A simplified accreditation option with minimal financial requirements which offers a quick and easy route to IATA accreditation.
- Agents opting for this accreditation model can transact in the BSP using IATA EasyPay, a new pay-as-you-go e-wallet solution and customer cards, but will not have a BSP cash facility.



GoStandard: Standard Accreditation with cash facility

- Based on the existing accreditation, the GoStandard option is for agents that operate in a single market per local financial criteria. GoStandard agents will have access to all forms of payment and will operate under an enhanced risk management.
- All IATA accredited agents will fall under this model when NewGen ISS is implemented in their market but agents will have the option to convert to another model per their business needs.



GoGlobal: Multi-Country Accreditation

- For agents operating in multiple BSPs, GoGlobal accreditation offers a streamlined accreditation and risk management process with a single set of global financial requirements.
- GoGlobal accreditation means greater efficiencies and a simplified risk management process.
